By performing a free concert, the Knoxville Symphony provides the community exposure to classical music and showcases the talented musicians we have living in Knoxville.

**Who:** **Music Director Aram Demirjian** leads the Knoxville Symphony Chamber Orchestra in a concert of light pops, including timeless music of the stage and screen including “Waltz” from Tchaikovsky’s *Sleeping Beauty*, a tribute to Broadway composers Lerner and Loewe, and music from the films *Chicago* and the more recent *La La Land*.
